
Entry Requirements

- Evidence of Shahadat Al-Thanawaya Al Aama (general Secondary Education Certificate) or Qatar Senior School Certificate with 60% and above
- IELTS 5.0 or 62 TOEFL or equivalent OR
- 5 IGCSE/GCSE minimum C grades including English and Maths OR
- 2x E grades at UK A2 level or 2 x E grades at UK AS Level (with a minimum of 3 IGCSEs grade A-C including English and Maths) OR
- Successful completion of the Pre-Foundation (NOTE: all students will be required to sit and pass the communication and numeracy assessment before an offer is made)




